Message from the Chairman

Dear Members of Ingwelala

The late Mirriam Mlambo

As most of you will know Mirriam Mlambo worked in the Ingwelala Shop together with Joyful Ngobeni.

Sadly, Mirriam suddenly passed away at work on Saturday morning 6 August 2016 at the age of 44 and her funeral was held this past Saturday 13 August 2016. As we currently understand, Mirriam left two surviving sons (one a grade 7 learner and the older son undergoing a learnership with the Dept of Works in Phalaborwa) as well as numerous other family members that were financially dependent on her in some way or the other.

Mirriam was a calm, gentle person who was always so friendly and had a lovely smile for everyone visiting the Ingwelala Shop. She was a ray of sunshine and full of love that touched the hearts of many Ingwelala Members and their families. She was always helpful in the Shop and welcomed us Members whenever we returned to visit Ingwelala, remembering the names of our children and asking how they were doing. Many Members have sent wonderful messages of remembrance of Mirriam and all of them will miss her terribly.

We currently have in place death, disability and funeral benefits for all the Ingwelala Staff through the Alexander Forbes Provident Fund that they all are members of, and to which Ingwelala funds 50% of the required monthly contribution. The Ingwelala Management Committee of the Provident Fund (comprising myself, John and Natalie Llewellyn, Andrew Rossaak, Selinah Chiloane and Joyful Ngobeni) will be responsible for investigating and identifying all the possible people that were financially dependent on Mirriam at the time of her death, and recommending to the Trustees of the Provident Fund, the proposed basis of distribution of the death benefits (which must be dealt with in accordance with the provisions of the Pension Funds Act).

Some Members have expressed an interest in donating money to the surviving family of Mirriam and in this regard, we suggest the same death benefit distribution protocol be followed. Donations can be made into Ingwelala's bank account but must carry a payment reference of "Mirriam" in order that it can be identified and tracked. The closing date for donations will be 30 September 2016 with distribution made shortly thereafter.
