

## Christopher Gregory – Curriculum Vitae



I am a Chartered Accountant of 44 years, (originally from the UK) having worked in the Accountancy Profession and subsequently in Commerce. During that period, I held the post of Finance Director for Mobil Oil in several European and African countries, Regional Financial Officer for Coca-Cola's Middle East Operations, and MasterCard's Chief Financial Officer for South Asia, Middle East and Africa.

I am now a retired permanent South African resident. My wife, Helen and I live in Hoedspruit and are 100% owners of 178, and have been so for 20 years.
